It is my right to vote.



DIGNITY & RESPECT

It is my right to be treated like a person and to feel safe. I deserve respect like everyone else. It is my right to tell others when I am not happy. They should listen to me and make changes to fix the problem.



It is my right to access my money and the things that belong to me.

INDIVIDUALITY

It is my right to have my own dreams and goals. I do not have to have the same dreams as everyone else.

It is my right to get the information I need to make choices. I will ask people to explain it if I do not understand something.
