The purpose of CCMHP is to provide support and intervention for children served by SCLARC who have mental health symptoms or are at risk for developing mental illness to improve resilience and well-being.

### Criteria for a referral include:

- ◆ A recent psychiatric hospitalization
- ◆ A recent referral for crisis services
- ◆ Self-harm or aggression
- ◆ A history of being bullied
- ◆ Trauma/loss/grief
- ◆ Suspected abuse or neglect

### GOALS

- \* Reduce mental health symptoms
- \* Connect with community mental health services
- \* Provide training to providers
