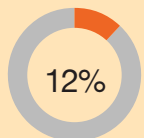
#### Intellectual Disability

Intellectual disability is a term used when there are limits to a person's ability to learn at an expected level and function in daily life.



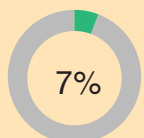
#### Autism

A group of complex disorders of brain development which are characterized, in varying degrees, by difficulties in social interaction, verbal and nonverbal communication, and repetitive behaviors.



#### Epilepsy

A spectrum condition with a wide range of seizure types and control varying from person-to-person



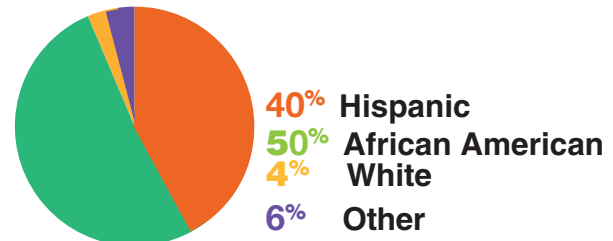
#### Cerebral Palsy
