

## COMMUNITY PLACEMENT PLAN PROPOSED 2020-2021 START-UP PROJECTS POSTED FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Below is a list of the proposed grant projects for the 2020-21 fiscal year, through the Community Placement Plan. Project #1 (CPP)	One non-ambulatory Enhance Behavioral Support Home (EBSH) to support adults with moderate to severe intellectual disabilities and severe behavioral issues. The facility will serve individuals moving from Porterville Developmental Center and those living in the community, but are at risk for institutional placement.
Project #2 (CPP)	One non-ambulatory Enhance Behavioral Support Home (EBSH) to support individuals who have a history of re- offending due to substance abuse issues. The facility will serve individuals moving from Porterville Developmental Center and those living in the community, but are at risk for institutional placement.
Project #3 (CPP)	Start-up funding for one business, experienced in providing therapy services to provide drug counseling, anger management, and competency training to individuals residing in the EBSH developed through project #2. SCLARC will also contract with the company to provide competency training services to individuals residing in other living options.

Project #4 (CPP)	One Adult Residential Facility for Persons with Health Services Needs for individuals with moderate to severe behavioral issues and health care needs that cannot be addressed in community care facilities. Health care conditions may include insulin dependence; Diazepam injections and suppositories to control seizures.
Project #5 (CRDP)	Two 6- bed ICF/DD-N facilities and one 4-bed, non- ambulatory, medical model specialized adult residential facility in order to reduce the vendored capacity of an existing large ICF/DD facility from 53 to 37 beds.
Project #6 (CRDP)	Three 4-bed, level 3 – 4A adult residential facilities to begin downsizing one large adult residential facility. The vendored capacity will be reduced from 48 to 36.
