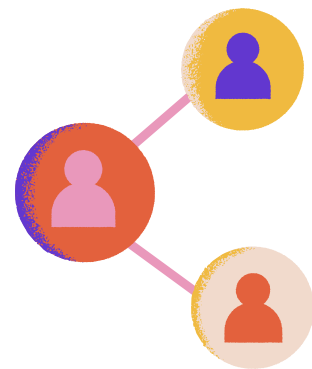




5 Facts about the Transition Conference

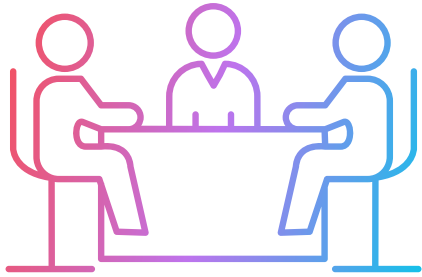
01

You and your Service Coordinator will schedule the Transition Conference when your child is between 2.8-2.9 years of age with the Local Educational Agency to begin to discuss the assessment process of the Individualized Education Plan.



02

You will participate in the Transition Conference with your invitee, Local Education Agency and Service Coordinator to develop the Transition Plan so it can reflect your child's strengths, areas of concern, and your priorities.



03

You will receive information about special education programs provided by Local Education Agency, Regional Center and Community programs.



04

You will follow up with the school district to sign the assessment plan or enroll your child to begin the assessment process. The assessment plan is a written permission to complete the assessments for the Individualized Education Plan (IEP). The Local Education Agency will schedule you and your child for assessments.



05

After the assessments, you and your invitees will participate in the Individualized Education Plan (IEP) meeting with the Local Education Agency to review the results, eligibility and discuss recommendations
