
PRESENTER:

Previous to working with the crisis team, Marisa has worked as a counselor, teacher, DSP, and IHSS worker. She specializes in working with clients with autism who are non-verbal.

- Provide crisis prevention, intervention, training, and follow-up services as support to community homes, day programs, and families
- Tools for assisting caregivers with crisis de-escalation, reinforcement strategies, and approaches to avoid
- Overview of common mood, anxiety, and psychotic disorders will be provided
- What to expect when law enforcement responds to a call for assistance and how to communicate with police officers such as helpful information to share, questions to be expected, and typical procedures practiced
