WHAT IS PROVISIONAL ELIGIBILITY

A three or four year old child who does not have a developmental disability may still be able to get regional center services under provisional eligibility.

A child ages 3 to 4 shall be provisionally eligible for regional center services if the child has a disability that is not solely physical in nature and has significant functional limitations in at least two of the following areas of major life activity:

- Self-care
- Receptive and expressive language
- Learning
- Mobility
- Self-direction

The child will be evaluated at least 90 days before turning 5 years of age to determine if they are eligible for regional center services after age 5.
