

Ascary Navarro

Currently, Mr. Navarro works as a Quality Assurance Specialist at Parenthood Partners and Family Services. Mr. Navarro has been active in the Advocate Advisory Committee as a member and secretary for four and a half years. He has also been active in the Board of Directors for 6 years and was recently elected as secretary for the board. Mr. Navarro is also a member of the Consumer Services Committee since 2019. Besides his roles in the above committees, he has also been a speaker at conferences from 2017 to 2019. He was a speaker at the "People First and Supported Life Conference" where he discussed joining the board and obtaining employment skills. One of his personal goals is to provide a voice for those who need to speak. Mr. Navarro hopes to better understand the community and the families by learning what is happening around them as well as providing quality support if needed. Another one of his main goals is to continue to help people and break stereotypes to move forward with progress. Ascary Navarro has served as a representative of the advocate group and has served as Board Secretary for two years.

Sherita Rogers

Sherita Rogers currently works as an Inclusion Teacher creating awareness amongst the school community of inclusive practices which support all learners in the General Education Classroom setting for the Los Angeles Unified School District.

Ms. Rogers has sat on SCLARC's board for the past 6 years where she has become a more informed advocate for parents and learners within the highneeds population, including academically and socially challenged youth. In the past, Sherita has also worked for Culver City School District and Independent Living Services (ILS) programs as an assistant supervisor.

Ms. Rogers is a STEAM- based educator and vocal advocate who passionately promotes the rights and needs of individuals and families in the disability community and a proud member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority.

Luz Curiel

My name is Luz Curiel, I am a parent at South Central Los Angeles Regional Center. My daughter, Olvia Curiel has been part of the Regional for 37 years.

During Olvia's school age years, I worked in sales to accommodate my schedule and be available to her. With the support of my husband and daughter (Olvia's only sister) I was able to build a successful business. In 2006, after losing my oldest brother to cancer I decided to leave the sales industry and focus on my family.

In 2007, I was presented with the opportunity to work as an Independent Living Skills Instructor. I felt that the experiences I had in navigating the system for support and generic resources would be of benefit to the field along with my personal experiences. I contemplated this position as I knew the importance of this job. Shortly after I started this position, I began to build relationships with the individuals we worked with and their families. I learned more from them than they did from me.

In 2011, I became a grandmother and took some time off to help my daughter. At this time, I built relationships with families and my daughter Olvia had made a new circle of friends. Olvia continued to be involved in peer groups.

Eight years ago, a group of parents and myself decided to create a group where our children could have a space to socialize and interact. Initially we named it Estrellas Brillantes, now known as Shining Stars. Shining Stars is a very active group in the city of Downey. We have built relationships with businesses to give us opportunities to hold our classes, karaoke, and parties. Shining Stars meets every Friday for Karaoke at Downey Dance Center. Throughout the year we have different themes Fiesta Mexicana, Luau, Dodger Night, Laker Night, Rock-n-roll, Mardi gras to mention a few. The participants enjoy dressing up. We have a Hip Hop group of dancers that compete twice per year in February and March. Hip Hop classes are every Wednesday. Shining Stars also attends a Long Beach Aquarium special event in January. In 2022, they had the opportunity to perform their Hip Hop routine. In February, Shining Stars has their Valentine's Day dance at Downey Woman's Club. During the summer we have our annual picnic. In June, we hold our Anniversary Dance also at Downey Woman's Club. Shining Stars has also been invited to participate at school carnivals to perform. They have danced at St. Dominic Savio Fall Fiesta and Our Lady of Perpetual Help school festival. In the fall, we have our Movie Day, Halloween Party, and Thanksgiving Dinner. December is our busiest month and most enjoyable. Starting with our Christmas Performance Recital. The city of Downey parade. Then our Christmas Party at Woman's Club where Santa is always a big hit. Lastly, we end the year with our Posada the third Friday of December. Our participants have the opportunity to participate in the traditional Posada. Shining Stars is a very active group throughout the year. The participants, families, and community has helped maintain this unity throughout the years.
